THROUGH THE BRIDGING PROGRAMME**



The Catholic University of Malawi invites suitably qualified persons to apply for various programmes tenable at its Campuses St. Montfort in Nguludi, Chiradzulu and St. Thomas More in Lilongwe. To be considered, candidates must apply by completing and submitting their application forms.

The Bridging Programme will run from 16th December 2025 to **24th January, 2026.**

The closing date for receiving such applications is **13th December, 2025**

Applicants who satisfy admission requirements are advised to arrive on Monday, **15th December, 2025.**

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE BRIDGING PROGRAMME/ WHO SHOULD APPLY
Those with Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE), or its equivalent, with **six credits including English and an aggregate of not more than thirty-six (36) points.**

The university interpretation of IGCSE and O-Level as an equivalent to MSCE is as follows: IGCSE; A-1, A=2, B-3, C=5, D=7, E-8, F=9 GCE
O-Level: A-1, B-3, C-5, D=7; E-8
PLEASE, NOTE THAT:

1) the Catholic University **WILL NOT** publish a list of eligible candidates before the commencement of the Programme. Therefore, **ONLY THOSE** who meet the entry requirements may report for classes. Only those who pass end-of-Bridging Examinations will be admitted into the Catholic University of Malawi.



UNIVERSITY ADMISSION POLICY

METHOD OF APPLICATION

a) APPLICATION FORMS

Application forms are available at the following places: the University Campus at Montfort-Nguludi in Chiradzulu, the Catholic Secretariat (Area 11, Lilongwe), St. John's Secondary School (Lilongwe), Mary Mount Secondary School and Mzuzu Technical College (Mzuzu), and all Catholic Diocesan Education Offices (Karonga, Mzuzu, Lilongwe, Dedza, Mangochi, Zomba, Blantyre, Chikwawa). b) APPLICATION FEE

Applicants should pay a non-refundable application fee of **MK25,000 (for local students) or USD25 (for foreign students)**. The University does not receive cash, postal orders or cheque payment. The University does not have a Mpamba or Airtel Money Account.
